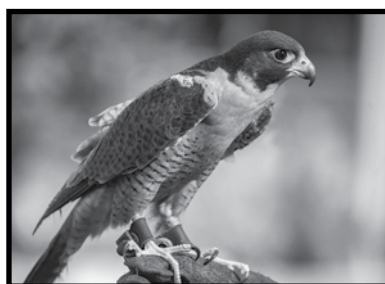

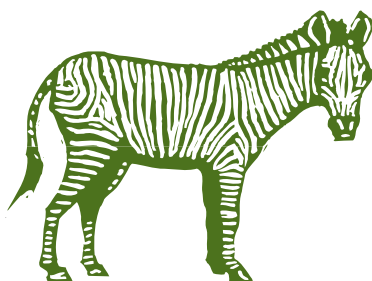

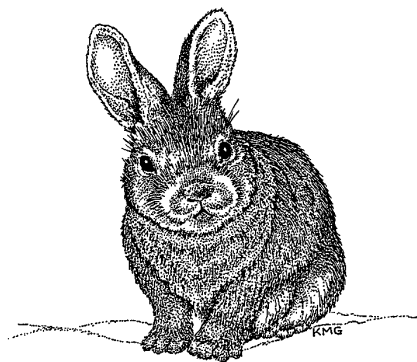
Mammalogy

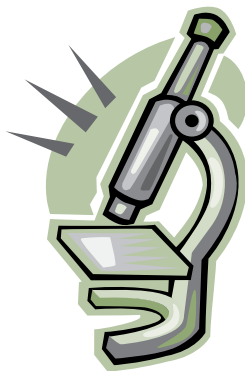

- Our hospital is the first and one of the largest wildlife rehabilitation centers in the United States.
- Established in 1970, the hospital is a recognized national leader and pioneer of wildlife rehabilitation.
- Hospital staff and volunteers treated more than 5,200 animals in 2017.
- Lindsay relies on donations to operate. The average cost to care for a single patient is \$100.

WILDLIFE SAFETY TIPS

- Do not use rodent poison or sticky traps
- Keep bird feeders clean
- Keep your cat indoors
- Avoid feeding the ducks
